Introduction

- Core question: What is the church's purpose and mission?
- Comparison to businesses like Coca-Cola having clear purposes
- Primary purpose revealed in Matthew 28:18-20: Making disciples of all nations

Point 1: Understanding Our True Purpose

- Common misconceptions about church's purpose:
 - Fellowship (important but not primary)
 - Worship (vital but not the main purpose)
 - Teaching/preaching (necessary but not the ultimate goal)
- Acts 2 example: Early church didn't stay in upper room just worshipping
- Priority must be outward-focused disciple-making

Point 2: Breaking Down the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)

- "Go into all the world" Moving beyond comfort zones
- "Make disciples" More than just converts
- "Baptizing them" Incorporating into church community & a public declaration of faith
- "Teaching them" Passing on Christ's commands

Point 3: The Church as God's Vehicle for Transformation

- Church planting impacts whole communities
- Personal testimony from African ministry experience:
- Jonah 4:10-11 illustration God's heart for cities and communities & His concern for all aspects of society (even livestock)

Conclusion & Practical Applications

- Keep the main mission (disciple-making) as primary focus and remember Christ's promise: "I am with you always"
- Look beyond comfortable boundaries
- Focus on relationship-building
- Participate in church and group planting
