

Introduction

- Jesus' blood is **precious** because it brings forgiveness (*Heb. 9:22*) and shows the depth of His love. Beyond being a legal sacrifice, His blood reveals His **emotional, passionate, willing love** for us.
- No other faith shows God so deeply involved in love for humanity (*Rom. 5:7–8*).

Point 1: The Preciousness of Jesus' Blood

- Old Testament sacrifices foreshadowed Christ: atonement required blood (*Lev. 17:11*).
- Jesus gave His **sinless blood** in our place, fulfilling the picture.
- His blood represents not only physical life but the **soul — emotions, will, and heart**.

Point 2: Love Demonstrated in His Suffering

- Jesus' blood is saturated with His **passion, compassion, and determination** (*Eph. 5:25*).
- Isaiah 53:4–12 — He bore our griefs, carried our sorrows, was wounded for our sins.
 - This whole passage is proof that His suffering was **emotional as well as physical**.
- Gethsemane: deep anguish, sweating blood (*Matt. 26:38–39; Luke 22:44*).
- On the cross: forgiveness (*Luke 23:34*), care (*John 19:26–27*), anguish (*Matt. 27:46*), completion (*John 19:30*).
- His heart literally broke — blood and water flowed from His side (*John 19:34*).

Point 3: The Eternal Voice of His Blood

- Jesus poured out His **soul unto death** (*Isa. 53:12*).
- His blood still speaks today (*Heb. 12:24*) — not judgment, but forgiveness and love.
- A continual reminder that His love is real and eternal.

Conclusion & Life Application

- Jesus' blood proves His love beyond doubt and calls for our response. His blood still speaks: *"I love you."* Receive His love, abide in it, and share it with others.
- **Applications:**
 - Trust God's love even when you don't feel it (*Eph. 3:18–19*).
 - Worship with passion and gratitude.
 - Love others sacrificially — family, friends, even enemies (*John 15:9, 13; Matt. 5:44*).
